You're heading to one of the 7 Natural Wonders of the World! What do you take with you on your full day adventure? Depending on the time you visit, it will either be dry (June to November) or rainy season (December to May). Now, please keep in mind that the dry and rainy season doesn't necessarily mean it will not rain or that it will. The weather is very unpredictable so we recommend being prepared for both weather conditions. The list below is our recommended day wear for our full day Machu Picchu trek. You will be departing from Cusco early so you want to layer up but once at the ruins you can layer down. Enjoy!

### Clothing

- ☐ T-shirt (polyester is ideal)
- ☐ Nylon Pant
- ☐ Soft Socks
- ☐ Waterproof hiking boots (recommended)
- ☐ Fleece sweater
- ☐ Rain jacket or poncho
- ☐ Gloves
